Frequently Asked Questions

Q. When will you go to the township for approval?

A. Lenhardt Rodgers and the Board Property Committee continue to work through conceptual and schematic plans. A sketch plan has been provided to Pennsbury Township for discussion purposes, and a formal land development plan submission is planned to occur over the winter.

Q. When will we be able to see architectural renderings of the buildings?

A. We shared at the recent CRA and Dialogue meetings building outlines and where they will be located on the campus. The Woolman building replacement will be constructed roughly on the same footprint as it is now. The Mott Area Expansion will be near and around the Mott house parking lot. The committee is still in the conceptual stages, and future drafts of architectural renderings will be shared with the community as they are created and approved.

Q. When can we provide feedback on these projects?

A. We have started to meet with residents who live near these areas for feedback and are planning community-wide meetings in the next few weeks dedicated to the two projects for an open discussion with the residents.

Q. Is there a conflict between adding parking and the preservation of open space?

A. Yes. As we expand the number of parking spots, it will result in the removal of open space. However, we are looking closely at underground parking. While this has added cost, we can realize the benefit of preserved open space and less stormwater management.
