Yesterday, the CDC announced updated public health guidance. New evidence on the highly contagious Delta variant circulating in the U.S recommends that all persons, regardless of vaccination status, wear a mask in public indoor settings, especially where there are areas of high transmission. In addition, the CDC follows the science, and new evidence suggests that fully vaccinated persons who become infected with the Delta variant can spread it to others. The guidance is significant for those who are immunocompromised or who are at an increased risk of severe disease.

Unfortunately, we are not out of this pandemic, and we must all continue to be safe. The good news is that the vaccine is doing its job - - preventing severe illness, hospitalizations, and death.

With increased travel during the summer months, enjoy your time, but please be cautious. Keep a proper social distance, avoid large crowds, remain outdoors as much as possible, and consider following the new CDC guidance and wear a mask in public indoor settings to protect yourself and others.
